OPTION 2: Leaze Farm visit by kind permission of Andrew Stevens. Leaze Farm covers about 200Ha owned and rented. The main enterprise is an autumn block calving dairy herd, calving 80% of the 340 cows in 6 weeks. We also run a 280 head beef calf unit. The objective is to run a low-cost system maximising profit per litre, with a yield per cow comfortably inside the cow's genetic potential. By not pushing for maximum yield, we can utilize a cheaper more forage-based ration, maintain good health and fertility resulting in longer lasting cows.

Participation in the afternoon trips is optional – you're also very welcome to stay at the hotel and take advantage of its excellent facilities at your leisure
